

- Labour will ensure a fully funded youth service.
- Labour will reinvest to ensure Children's Centre Services are retained and not subject to a post code lottery.
- Labour will ensure all pothole repairs will be made within 48 hours of complaint.
- Labour will invest in safe routes to schools and ensure 20 mph limits are in place where necessary.
- We will renegotiate all contracts to ensure the services revert to in-house provision or member owned co-operatives.
- We will ensure sport and physical activity is a priority and will invest in a fund to ensure equal access to sport.
